Bottle Model At Home Project



The Project

As part of our social studies program, the students have been learning about how different historical figures struggled, persevered, and endured; overcoming great obstacles to make our world a better place. The students have also been perfecting their non-fiction reading, writing, and researching skills to write biography reports and create trifold presentation boards at school that they will display in our classroom.

Monday, June 12th we will open the door to our classroom "Biography Museum", for students in other classrooms to tour. Each student in our class will take on the role of a "history docent" teaching students about their specific historian.

Materials Needed

- Empty liter bottle,
- Sand or Rocks to put into the bottle to stabilize the bottle model,
- Foam ball (for the head),
- Miscellaneous cloth, cotton balls, markers, glue, etc. to transform your bottle into a model of your historian.

Tip... It is not necessary to spend money on this project. Using recycled materials such as old clothes slated for the Goodwill is a cost-saving way to dress your model.
